## Schedule for Competitions 2022

**All WI's can enter all the classes.** The committee felt that after a gap of two years which have been difficult to a greater or lesser extent for all our members we should have a more relaxed feel about this year's exhibition, to encourage more members to have a go; not just the dedicated crafters or keen floral art experts.

### **PHOTOGRAPHY A Sunset or Sunrise**

Mounted not framed, no bigger than A4 overall.

**Max 3 per WI**



### **ART**

**A Chance to Reflect** - A picture, mounted not framed: watercolour, acrylic, pastel, collage, or a mixed media. Size overall no greater than 30cm x 40cm.

**Max 3 per WI**

### **FLORAL ART**

**Class 1: A Small Hanging Circlet or Wreath** using dried or artificial plant material. Finished size no greater than 12ins /30.5 cm overall.

**Max 2 per WI**

**Hand-Tied Bouquet** using fresh material only to be displayed in water. Finished size no greater than 10ins /25.5 cm.

### **CRAFT**

**Class 1: A Sock Creature** - let your imagination fly, have fun and create a creature from one pair of clean socks.

Recycle a worn pair or even two odd socks!

**Max 3 per WI**



**Class 2: A Hanging Storage pod** - An easy way to keep things tidy, must have a hanger. Size: no greater than 25cm high excluding hanger; base max 14cm wide/deep/or diameter.

**Max 3 per WI.**

**Class 3: A Macrame Wall Hanging, using a wooden (new or foraged) hanger.** Maximum two colours of yarn but may incorporate beads. Size no greater than 30 cm x 90 cm

**Max 3 per WI.**

**Class 4: A Fob - style Scissor Keeper** - Any medium.

**Max 3 per WI.**

with no additional staging; just a free-standing scarecrow, dressed in the fashion of your chosen decade from 1950s to present day.

**A SCARECROW - This is NOT a co-operative.**

WIs are invited to enter a free - standing scarecrow for a competition to be judged by public vote. 1 metre square floor space allowed
