### MEASUREMENTS AND SIZES

Height: 16cm tall

#### **KNIT KIT**

Yarn: Sirdar Snuggly DK in shades (A) 251 white OR 313 Whisper, (B) 510 Rose Bud OR 321 Pastel Blue, (C) 260 Summer Lime OR 219 Lilac, and (D) 461 Daisy Chain, one 50g ball of each; plus small amount of dark brown 4ply

Needles: 3mm

Buttons: 8mm salmon

pink, four

**Felt:** fawn, 3cm square; dark brown, 1cm square

Tapestry needle

Stitch holder

Safety toy stuffing

### **TENSION SQUARE**

28 sts x 36 rows 10cm x 10cm Stocking Stitch 3mm needles

### **ABOUT THE YARN**

### START KNITTING HERE...

### BODY FIRST LEG

Using 3mm needles and yarn A, cast on 15 sts

- Rows 1-21: starting with a
- p (WS) row, work in st st
- ☐ Cut yarn, keep sts on a holder

### **SECOND LEG**

Using 3mm needles and yarn A, cast on 15 sts

A, cast on 15 sts

Work as for First Leg.

Do not break yarn

- ☐ Row 22: k 15 sts of Second Leg, k sts from holder, to connect both legs. 30 sts
- ☐ Rows 23-39: starting with a p row, work in st st
- ☐ Row 40: (k1, k2tog) to end. 20 sts
- $\square$  Rows 41-45: starting with a
- p row, work in st st
- Row 46: (k2tog) to end. Ten sts
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through sts, pull tight and fasten off

### HEAD

Using 3mm needles and yarn A, cast on ten sts

- ☐ Row 1 (WS): p
- Row 2: (kfb) to end. 20 sts
- ☐ Row 3: p

4ply or DK yarn to add your bear's
mouth – you can even
use embroidery floss!"

- ☐ Row 4: (k1, kfb) to end. 30 sts☐ Row 5: p
- ☐ Row 6: (k2, kfb) to end. 40 sts☐ Rows 7-15: starting with a
- p row, work in st st  $\square$  Row 16: (k2, k2tog) to end.
- 30 sts
  ☐ Rows 17-19: starting with a
- p row, work in st st ☐ Row 20: (k1, k2tog) to end.
- 20 sts □ Row 21: p
- Row 21: p
- ☐ Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through sts, pull tight and fasten off

**EARS** (make two)
Using 3mm needles and yarn A, cast on 14 sts

- ☐ Rows 1-3: starting with a p row, work in st st
- ☐ Row 4: (k2tog) to end. Seven sts
- ☐ Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through sts, pull tight and fasten off

ARMS (make two)
Using 3mm needles and yarn A,
cast on ten sts
