

You will need:

Your own sewing machine (PAT tested) to sew the apron, (the appliqué can be done by hand.)

1 metre ticking fabric (length required for apron will vary according to person's height).

NB ticking is usually 60 inches wide therefore you should get 2 out of 1 metre.

 $2\frac{1}{2}$ metres of cotton tape for ties and straps.

1 metre Bondaweb or Heat 'n' Bond Lite

Cream Machine thread.

Matching machine threads for appliqués or stranded embroidery threads if hand sewing.

For the snowman, arms & icing on cake—white fabric 13 inches square.

Apron & hat brim (black/white strip on picture) - piece 8 inches by 11 inches.

Hat (black dot on white) piece 8 inches $\times 4\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

Apron band & brim band (green) - piece 8 inches \times 3 inches.

Dessert (black on picture) piece 5 inches $\times 3\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

Plate (red on picture) piece— $5\frac{1}{2} \times 2$ inches.

Nose—(orange) piece -3 inches \times 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
