DK YARN



3MM NEEDLES

MEASUREMENTS AND SIZES

Head circumference: 59cm

Length: 25cm

KNIT KIT

Yarn: DK, shades (A) Bright Yellow, (B) Perky Teal, (C) Lovely Violet, 100g of each

Needles: 3mm

Tapestry needle

TENSION SQUARE

■ 25 sts x 37 rows

■ 10cm x 10cm

■ Stocking Stitch

■ 3mm needles

Let's knit together

START KNITTING HERE...

ADULT HAT

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on 146 sts

□ Row 1 (WS): k2, rep (p2, k2) to end of row

□ Row 2: p2, rep (k2, p2) to end of row

□ These two rows set rib st

□ Row 3: work in rib as set

□ Join yarn C, do not cut yarn B

□ Rows 4-7: work in rib as set

□ Cut yarn C, re-join yarn B

□ Rows 8-11: work in rib as set

□ Cut yarn B, join yarn A

□ Work in rib as set until piece meas 7.5cm from the cast-on edge, ending with a Row 1

□ Beg with a k row, work in st st until piece meas 12cm from cast-on edge, ending with a p row

□ Cut yarn A, join yarn C

□ Beg with a k row, work 12 rows in st st, ending with a p row

Colourblock panel

□ Cut yarn C, join yarns A and B

□ Row 1: k9A, k8B, rep (k8A, k8B) seven times, k8A, k9B

□ Row 2: p9B, p8A, rep (p8B, p8A) seven times, p8B, p9A

□ Rows 3-8: Rep Rows 1-2 three times

Cont hat

□ Cut yarns A and B, join yarn C

□ Beg with a k row, work ten rows in st st, ending with a p row

□ Cut yarn C, join yarn B

□ Beg with a k row, work in st st until piece meas 23cm from cast-on edge, ending with a p row

Shape crown

□ Row 1: k1, rep (k10, k2tog) to last st, k1. 134 sts

□ Row 2: p

□ Row 3: k1, rep (k2, k2tog) to last st, k1. 101 sts



□ Row 4: p

□ Row 5: k1, rep (k1, k2tog) to last st, k1. 68 sts

□ Row 6: p

□ Row 7: k1, k2tog to last st, k1. 35 sts

□ Row 8: p

□ Row 9: k2, k2tog to last st, k1. 19 sts

□ Row 10: p

□ Row 11: k2, k2tog to last st, k1. 11 sts

□ Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through sts, pull tight and fasten off

TO MAKE UP

□ Using long fastened-off yarn B tail, join sides of Hat tog until 5cm from cast-on edge, then join rem sides tog with WS facing. Secure and weave in any rem tails, then make and attach a pompom made from yarn A (see panel) **LKT**

POMPOM PERFECTION

To make a quick and easy pompom, wrap yarn around a hard flat object (such as a spatula or a fork) many times, then cut the yarn on both sides to create a bundle of similarly sized strands. Wrap and knot a long length of yarn around the centre of this bundle, leaving two long ties that can be used to secure the pompom to the hat. Trim the pompom into an even shape, then secure to the hat to finish.

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
