### MEASUREMENTS AND SIZES

**Length:** 179cm

**Width:** 12.5cm

### KNIT KIT

**Yarn:** DK, shades (A) Bright  
Yellow, (B) Perky Teal, (C)  
Lovely Violet, 100g of each

**Needles:** 3mm

**Tapestry needle**

### TENSION SQUARE

■ 25 sts x 37 rows

■ 10cm x 10cm

■ Stocking Stitch

■ 3mm needles

**START  
KNITTING  
HERE...**

### SCARF

Using 3mm needles and yarn  
A, cast on 66 sts

□ Beg with a (RS) k row, work  
in st st for 21cm, ending  
with a p row

□ Cut yarn A, join yarn B

□ Rows 1-4: beg with a k row,  
work in st st

□ Join yarn C, do not cut  
yarn B

□ Rows 5-8: beg with a k row,  
work in st st

□ Do not cut yarn C, cont with  
yarn B

□ Rows 9-12: beg with a k row,  
work in st st

“If desired, you  
can block this  
piece by misting  
it gently with  
clean water,  
then pressing  
on the reverse  
side with a cool  
iron. Leave flat  
to thoroughly  
dry before  
finishing.”

- ☐ Cut yarn B, cont with yarn C
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 13cm, ending with a p row

### First colourblock panel

- ☐ Cut yarn C, join yarns A and B
- ☐ Row 1: k9A, k8B, (k8A, k8B) twice, k8A, k9B
- ☐ Row 2: p9B, p8B, (p8B, p8A) twice, p8B, p9A
- ☐ Rows 3-8: Rep Rows 1-2 three times

### Cont scarf

- ☐ Cut yarns A and B, join yarn C
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 5cm, ending with a p row
- ☐ Cut yarn C, join yarn B
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 24cm, ending with a p row
- ☐ Cut yarn B, join yarn A
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 8.5cm, ending with a p row
- ☐ Cut yarn A, join yarn C
- ☐ Rows 1-4: beg with a k row, work in st st
- ☐ Join yarn B, do not cut yarn C
- ☐ Rows 5-8: beg with a k row, work in st st
- ☐ Do not cut yarn B, cont with yarn C
- ☐ Rows 9-12: beg with a k row, work in st st
- ☐ Join yarn A, do not cut yarn C
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 6.5cm, ending with a p row
- ☐ Join yarn C, do not cut yarn A
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 11.5cm, ending with a p row
- ☐ Join yarn B, do not cut yarn C
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 7.5cm, ending with a p row

### Second colourblock panel

- ☐ Cut yarn B, join yarns A and C
- ☐ Row 1: k9C, k8A, (k8C, k8A) twice, k8C, k9A
- ☐ Row 2: p9A, p8C, (p8A, p8C) twice, p8A, p9C
- ☐ Rows 3-8: Rep Rows 1-2 three times

### Cont scarf

- ☐ Cut yarns A and C, join yarn B
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 12cm, ending with a p row
- ☐ Cut yarn B, join yarn C
- ☐ Rows 1-4: beg with a k row, work in st st
- ☐ Join yarn A, do not cut yarn C
- ☐ Rows 5-8: beg with a k row, work in st st
- ☐ Do not cut yarn A, cont with yarn C
- ☐ Rows 9-12: beg with a k row, work in st st
- ☐ Cut yarn C, cont in yarn A
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 12cm, ending with a p row
- ☐ Cut yarn A, join yarn C
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 5cm, ending with a p row

### Third colourblock panel

- ☐ Cut yarn C, join yarns A and B
- ☐ Row 1: k9A, k8B, rep (k8A, k8B) twice, k8A, k9B
- ☐ Row 2: p9B, p8A, rep (p8B, p8A) twice, p8B, p9A
- ☐ Rows 3-8: Rep Rows 1-2 three times

### Cont scarf

- ☐ Cut yarns A and B, join yarn C
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 12.5cm, ending with a p row
- ☐ Join yarn A
- ☐ Rows 1-4: beg with a k row, work in st st
- ☐ Do not cut yarn A, cont with yarn C
- ☐ Rows 5-8: beg with a k row, work in st st
- ☐ Cut yarn C, cont in yarn A
- ☐ Rows 9-12: beg with a k row, work in st st
- ☐ Cut yarn A, join yarn B
- ☐ Beg with a k row, work in st st for 21cm, ending with a p row
- ☐ Cast off kwise



### TO MAKE UP

- ☐ Secure and weave in all tails, and block if desired. Fold work in half vertically and use lengths of yarn A to join sides tog from centre to cast-on edge, then

seam folded cast-on edge tog to close. Rep for second half using lengths of yarn B to sew cast-off edge. **LKT**

## COOL COLOURWORK

This project uses the intarsia method of colourwork. You can either carry the spare yarns along the wrong side of the piece as you work, or cut and use separate lengths of yarn (approx 1m long) for each new block of colour.
