A little bit about Malham WI ...

Our WI was formed in 1929 by a group of forward-thinking women from Malham, Kirkby Malham, Hanlith, Malham Moor, Bell Busk, Otterburn and Airton. The first meeting was at the Cherries Farm in Malham thereafter it moved to St George's Hall (which used to be behind River House B&B) then in 1963 it moved to the Village Hall as we know it now. In 2020 we celebrated our 90th birthday at River House, in 2025 we are 95 years young!

Today we continue to promote the WI principles; even though we are a relatively small institute, we actively support the education and protection of children and women, take part in activities that mean the most to our community and campaign on issues which are highlighted locally and through the National Women's Institute. **We are proud of Malham WI.**
