EXCLUSIVE PROJECT: KIDS PATTERN

WHAT YOU NEED...



GREAT FOR BEGINNERS



DK YARN



3MM NEEDLES

MEASUREMENTS AND SIZES

Head circumference: 51cm

Height: 21cm

KNIT KIT

Yarn: DK, shades (A) Bold Plum, (B) Sparkly Pink, (C) Pale Pink, 100g of each

Needles: 3mm straight, two 3mm DPNs

Tapestry needle

TENSION SQUARE

- 25 sts x 37 rows
- 10cm x 10cm
- Stocking Stitch
- 3mm needles

KNIT AN I-CORD

The top of this cute little hat is made from a knotted length of i-cord. To make an i-cord, simply cast on the number of stitches stated in the pattern using two DPNs, then knit across the first row. Instead of swapping your needles as usual, slide the work to the opposite end of the working DPN and knit across the stitches once more. Repeat for however many rows the pattern states, then cast off as normal.

START KNITTING HERE...

TODDLER HAT

Using 3mm needles and yarn A, cast on 122 sts

- Beg with a (RS) k row, work in st st until piece meas 6cm from cast-on edge, ending with a p row
- Cut yarn A, leaving a long yarn tail. Join yarn B
- Beg with a k row, work in st st until piece meas 9.5cm from cast-on edge, ending with a p row
- Cut yarn B, join yarn C
- Beg with a k row, work in st st until piece meas 18.5cm from cast-on edge, ending with a p row

Shape crown

- Row 1: k1, rep (k13, k2tog) to last st, k1. 114 sts
- Row 2: p
- Row 3: k1, rep (k2, k2tog) to last st, k1. 86 sts

- Row 4: p
- Row 5: k1, rep (k1, k2tog) to last st, k1. 58 sts
- Row 6: p
- Row 7: k1, rep k2tog to last st, k1. 30 sts
- Row 8: p
- Row 9: k1, rep k2tog to last st, k1. 16 sts
- Row 10: p
- Row 11: k2tog to end. Eight sts
- Row 12: p2tog, p3, p2tog, p1. Six sts
- Work a six st i-cord for 12cm (see panel)
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through sts, pull tight and fasten off

TO MAKE UP

- Pass fastened-off yarn C tail through i-cord. Join a long length of yarn C to base of i-cord and sew sides of hat tog until you reach yarn A tail. Use yarn A tail to join rem sides of hat tog. Secure and weave in any rem tails. To finish, tie the top of hat into a knot **LKT**
