Schedule for Competitions 2018 Theme: "Home Sweet Home"

All WI's can enter all the classes

Photography

"A room with a view" - Mounted not framed, no bigger that A4 overall. Max 3 per WI

Floral Art

Class 1: A circular summer wreath using natural/fresh plant material (no artificial flowers); able to be hung. Base max 14 ins/35.5cms diameter. Finished size no greater than 24ins/61cms overall

Max 2 per WI

Class 2: A table top Cup and Saucer flower arrangement using fresh material only **Max 2 per WI**

PRODUCE

Class 1: A set recipe 'WRASCAL' – one only presented on an afternoon tea plate. Recipe will be supplied with entry form. (Please put your name on the underside of plate)

Max 3 per WI

Class 2: A savoury quiche incorporating Yorkshire Cheese (please state type of cheese used)

Max 3 per WI

Class 3: Three different items using Rhubarb. Displayed in a triangle **Max 1 per WI.**

CRAFT

Class 1: A handcrafted card 'Welcome to your new home.' Not computer generated. Blank inside, no envelopes

Max 3 per WI

Class 2: A decorated coat hanger, any medium, any craft **Max 3 per WI**.

Class 3: Hot water bottle cover, any medium, displayed on a hot water bottle **Max 3 per WI**.

THE CO-OP ENTRY

'A Scarecrow' - Incorporating three items to be judged. 1 Craft, 1 Produce and 1 Floral item. These to be identified for judging. Maximum width 1 Metre. Must be free standing. To be viewed from the front. **Max 1 per WI**

ENTRIES TO BE MADE SINCE LAST YEAR'S SHOW. NO EXHIBITS FROM PREVIOUS SHOWS. ANY SOILED OR FADED ITEMS WILL NOT BE JUDGED.

Entry forms and schedule guide will be sent for your April meeting and should then be returned to Alma House no later than Friday, 22nd June 2018.

Photography and Craft Classes should be at Alma House no later than the 22nd June 2018 for judging prior to the show. The GYS committee will transport them to the show ground.

All other Classes to be brought to our GYS Pavilion either on Sunday 8th July 2018 between 11am – 4pm or Monday 9th July 2018 between 9am – 12noon.
