The resolution will form the basis of a WI Campaign and in the next few months National will develop a campaign plan for WIs to use.

It could be arranging CPR training for the own members or the wider community, fundraising for a defibrillator in their areas or raising awareness of the disparity in the survival rate between women and men.

MEMBERSHIP & TRAINING

I hope many of you were able to watch the NFWI Annual meeting; it's great to hear from the National Chair about all the things we have achieved in the last year and plans for the future. As Chris mentioned in the Chairman's Chat, the new constitutions have now been adopted and all WIs must now action these.

The new constitution is now available on MyWI for every WI to read and sign. You must print a copy and complete the information on the last page. The information you will need is the name of your WI, the name of the Federation (Northamptonshire), your WI reference which you will find on MCS. The President and Secretary then need to sign the document and send a copy of the signed constitution to WI House and then the original copy must be kept with your WI documentation. The previous constitution then needs to be stored in your archive.

The new constitution can be found on MyWI – Essential Information – WI Policy and Guidance – Constitution and Rules for WIs (2025).
