

CUDDLE BUNNY

Materials

- ♥ **A yarn such as:** Patons Fab DK, approx. 274m/100g ball (100% acrylic)
1 ball in Beige (B) 2308
Patons Fab DK, approx. 68m/25g ball (100% acrylic)
1 ball in White (W) 2306
1 ball in Pink 2304
- ♥ Pair of 3.75mm needles
- ♥ Tapestry needle
- ♥ Toy filling

Tension

22 stitches and 30 rows over 10cm stocking stitch.

SMALLER BUNNY

Body and head

Using 3.75mm needles and beige yarn, cast on 12 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: [Inc 1, k1] 6 times. (18 sts)

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: [Inc 1, k1] 9 times. (27 sts)

Work 10 rows in stocking stitch.

Row 15: P13, p2tog, p12. (26 sts)

In foll row, join white (W) and weave beige (B) across the back of the work.

Row 16: K11B, k4W, k11B.

Row 17: P10B, k6W, k10B.

Row 18: K9B, k8W, k9B.

Row 19: P8B, k10W, k8B.

Row 20: K7B, k12W, k7B.

Row 21: P3B, p2togB, p1B, p3W, p2togW, p4W, p2togW, p4B, p2togB, p1B. (22 sts)

Row 22: K1B, k2togB, k3B, k2togW, k3W, k2togW, k3W, k2B, k2togB, k2B. (18 sts)

Row 23: P2B, p2togB, p1B, p1W, p2togW, p2W, p2togW, p1W, p2B, p2togB, p1B. (14 sts)

Break off white yarn.

Row 24: [Inc 1, k1] 7 times. (21 sts)

Work 9 rows in stocking stitch.

Row 34: [K1, k2tog] 7 times. (14 sts)

Row 35: [P2tog] 7 times. (7 sts)

Break off yarn and thread through stitches on needle.

Draw tight and secure the end.

Arms (make 2)

Using 3.75mm needles and beige yarn, cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: [Inc 1] 4 times. (8 sts)

Work 9 rows in stocking stitch.

Row 12: [K2tog] 4 times. (4 sts)

Break off yarn and thread through stitches on needle.

Draw tight and secure the end.

Feet (make 2)

Using 3.75mm needles and beige yarn, cast on 6 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: [Inc 1] 6 times. (12 sts)

Work 9 rows in stocking stitch.

Row 12: [K2tog] 6 times. (6 sts)

Row 13: [K2tog] 3 times. (3 sts)

Break off yarn and thread through stitches on needle.

Draw tight and secure the end.

Tail

Using 3.75mm needles and white yarn, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2: [Inc 1 knitwise] 3 times. (6 sts)

Row 3: [Inc 1 knitwise] 6 times. (12 sts)

Work 2 rows in garter stitch.

Row 6: [K2tog] 6 times. (6 sts)

Row 7: [K2tog] 3 times. (3 sts)

Break off yarn and thread through stitches on needle.

Draw tight and secure the end.

Outer ears (make 2)

Using 3.75mm needles and beige yarn, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (RS): [Inc 1] twice k1. (5 sts)

Row 2: Inc 1, p2, inc 1, p1. (7 sts)

Work 4 rows in stocking stitch.

Row 7: K2tog, k3, k2tog. (5 sts)

Work 3 rows in stocking stitch.

Row 11: K2tog, k1, k2tog. (3 sts)

Work 3 rows in stocking stitch.

Cast off.

Inner ears (make 2)

Using 3.75mm needles and pink yarn, cast on 3 sts.

Work as for Outer ears.

Making up

For the body and head, partially sew up side seam, using mattress stitch or backstitch, insert stuffing and complete the seam.

For the arms and feet, with the stocking stitch side facing outwards, fold the each piece in half and sew together around the outer edge.

For ears, with the stocking stitch side facing outwards, sew the two pieces together, using mattress stitch or backstitch, around the edge.

Using picture as guide, embroider the mouth and nose using backstitch, eyes using satin stitch and make whiskers. Using matching yarn, attach arms, feet, tail and ears.

LARGER BUNNY

Body and head

Using 3.75mm needles and beige yarn, cast on 12 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: [Inc 1, k1] 6 times. (18 sts)

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: [Inc 1, k1] 9 times. (27 sts)

Row 5: Purl.

Row 6: [Inc 1, k2] 9 times. (36 sts)

Work 14 rows in stocking stitch.

Row 21: P17, p2tog, p17. (35 sts)

In foll row, join white (W) and weave beige (B) across the back of the work.

Row 22: K17B, k1W, k17B.



Row 23: P16B, k3W, k16B.
 Row 24: K15B, k5W, k15B.
 Row 25: P3B, [p2togB, p3B] twice, p1B, p7W, p1B, [p2togB, p3B] twice, p3B. (31 sts)
 Row 26: K2B, [k2togB, k2B] twice, k1B, k2togW, k5W, k2togW, k1B, [k2togB, k2B] twice, k2B. (25 sts)
 Row 27: P2B, [p2togB, p1B] twice, p1W, p2togW, p3W, p2togW, p1W, [p2togB, p1B] twice, p2B. (19 sts)
 Break off white yarn.
 Row 28: K1, [inc 1, k1] 9 times. (28 sts)
 Work 15 rows in stocking stitch.
 Row 44: K1, [k2tog, k2] 6 times, k2tog, k1. (21 sts)
 Row 45: Purl.
 Row 46: [K1, k2tog] 7 times. (14 sts)
 Row 47: [P2tog] 7 times. (7 sts)
 Break off yarn and thread through stitches on needle.
 Draw tight and secure the end.

Arms (make 2)

Using 3.75mm needles and beige yarn, cast on 8 sts.
 Row 1 (WS): Purl.
 Row 2: [Inc 1] 4 times. (8 sts)
 Work 9 rows in stocking stitch.
 Row 12: [K2tog] 4 times. (4 sts)
 Break off yarn and thread through stitches on needle.
 Draw tight and secure the end.

Feet (make 2)

Using 3.75mm needles and beige yarn, cast on 10 sts.
 Row 1 (WS): Purl.
 Row 2: [Inc 1] 6 times. (12 sts)
 Work 9 rows in stocking stitch.
 Row 12: [K2tog] 6 times. (6 sts)
 Row 13: [K2tog] 3 times. (3 sts)
 Break off yarn and thread through stitches on needle.
 Draw tight and secure the end.

Tail

Using 3.75mm needles and white yarn, cast on 4 sts.
 Row 1 (WS): Knit.
 Row 2: [Inc 1, knitwise] 4 times. (8 sts)
 Row 3: [Inc 1, knitwise] 8 times. (16 sts)
 Work 4 rows in garter stitch.
 Row 8: [K2tog] 8 times. (8 sts)
 Row 9: [K2tog] 4 times. (4 sts)
 Break off yarn and thread through stitches on needle.
 Draw tight and secure the end.

Outer ears (make 2)

Using 3.75mm needles and beige yarn, cast on 3 sts.
 Row 1 (RS): [Inc 1] twice, k1. (5 sts)
 Row 2: Inc 1, p2, inc 1, p1. (7 sts)
 Row 3: Inc 1, k4, inc 1, k1. (9 sts)
 Work 7 rows in stocking stitch.
 Row 11: K1, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k1. (7 sts)
 Work 3 rows in stocking stitch.
 Row 15: K1, k2tog, k1, k2tog, k1. (5 sts)
 Work 3 rows in stocking stitch.
 Row 19: K2tog, k1, k2tog. (3 sts)
 Work 3 rows in stocking stitch.
 Cast off.

Inner ears (make 2)

Using 3.75mm needles and pink yarn, cast on 3 sts.
 Work as for Outer ears.

Making up

For the body and head, partially sew up side seam, using mattress stitch or backstitch, insert stuffing and complete the seam.
 For the arms and feet, with the stocking stitch side facing outwards, fold the each piece in half and sew together around the outer edge.
 For ears, with the stocking stitch side facing outwards, sew the two pieces together, using mattress stitch or backstitch, around the edge.
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 Using matching yarn, attach arms, feet, tail and ears.
